### **Finances**

The 2014 meeting was financed by equal contributions from Novo Nordisk, BI/Lilly and Sanofi. The CSED account remains in positive balance (approximately £8000).

Following long-standing issues with access to the previous account (Clydesdale Bank), a new RBS account has been set up. Existing standing orders will cease to be collected when the previous account is closed (early in 2015) and members will be invited to set up standing orders with the new account.

### **Next annual meeting**

Although BES has been rescheduled to occur in early November (following ENDO moving to March), the general consensus is this would not have a detrimental effect upon attendance at a CalSoc meeting occurring in late November / early December. Unless there are substantial objections, I would envisage CalSoc 2015 will occur on the Friday/Saturday of either 27/28 November or 4/5 December 2015.

### **Committee membership**

CalSoc has historically had a committee member from a District General Hospital in addition to representatives from the 4 university centres. I would be grateful to hear from any members wishing to join the committee. In the event of more than one application, the appointment will be decided following a vote. **The closing date for applications is 18<sup>th</sup> December 2014.**
